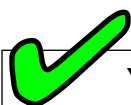

Bins should be presented for collection by 7am and returned to your property as soon as possible after emptying. All waste should be contained in the bin with the lid closed.

All recycling materials should be clean. Please remember to 'rinse and squash' bottles and cans etc. Flattening boxes and crushing cans will allow you to fit more in your bin and will make the materials easier for us to handle.



### Yes Please

- Paper; cardboard; juice & milk cartons
- Plastic bottles; yoghurt pots; margarine tubs; carrier bags; plastic ice-cream tubs; plastic food trays.
- Cans & tins; metal lids from jars; empty aerosol cans; aluminium foil.
- Glass bottles & jars

**All recycling should be clean and free from food or liquid waste.**

**No black sacks please**

### No Thank You

- Black bags; food waste; household waste; nappies; sanitary products; pet waste; tissues or cotton buds.
- Electrical items; batteries; paint; oils; mirrors; sheet glass; gas bottles or extinguishers.
- Clothes; toys; polystyrene; crisp packets; sweet wrappers; cling film; garden waste.

If you are not sure of how to dispose of a particular item, please check the Council website or contact Wellingborough Norse for advice. If you put the wrong materials in the recycling bin, we may not be able to empty it. Dealing with contaminated recycling costs a lot of money.
